

To'hajiilee Community Update from CBNHC: As of August 11, 2022 we have recorded 1408 **positive** total cases of coronavirus. **We have had 14 new positive cases in the past 7 days**, and 20 positive cases for the month of August. **July = 14.3 %** **August= 15%**

As of 8-11-2022:

ADULT: 2109 #1, 1931 #2, 1117 #3, 205 #4

5-11 YEAR OLDS: 116 #1, 52 #2, 22 #3

6 MONTHS- 4 YEAR OLDS: 10 #1, 5 #2

News: Known daily case counts have begun to tick downward in recent days, accompanied by similar declines in test positivity and hospitalizations so far this month. The virus is still infecting around 120,000 people each day, a higher level than was reported for much of the spring and summer. Yet the recent declines suggest that conditions may be improving. Cases have decreased since mid-July in more than half of all states, and in the states where cases are increasing, the changes are small. After increasing steadily from April through July, the number of Americans hospitalized with coronavirus has decreased slightly throughout this week. If that trend holds, it would mark a significant reversal. Deaths have increased modestly in recent weeks, but they remain lower than they have been at most points in the pandemic. Fewer than 500 deaths are currently announced each day, down from more than 2,600 per day at the height of the Omicron surge.
