

To'hajiilee Community Update from CBNHC: As of September 1, 2022 we have recorded 1421 **positive** total cases of coronavirus. **We have had 4 new positive cases in the past 7 days**, and 32 positive cases for the month of August. **July = 14.3 % August= 7.7 %**

News: The Food and Drug Administration on Wednesday authorized the first redesign of coronavirus vaccines since they were rolled out in late 2020, setting up millions of Americans to receive new booster doses targeting Omicron subvariants as soon as next week. The agency cleared two options aimed at the BA.5 variant of Omicron that is now dominant: one made by Pfizer and its German partner BioNTech for use in people as young as 12, and the other by Moderna, for those 18 and older. While CBNHC clinic does not have this new bivalent vaccine on hand yet, we will advertise as soon as we get it in. An Omicron specific booster dose will be hugely beneficial to help prevent severe illness, hospitalization, and death due to the Omicron sub-variants as we head into autumn and winter.

Covid testing and vaccinations at CBNHC:

Mondays 1-3:30 , Tuesday through Friday: 1- 2pm. We will offer home testing kits to people that show up at other times. Pfizer **PEDIATRIC** Clinics- Wednesdays by appointment, Pfizer **ADULT** vaccines: Fridays by appointment, Moderna Clinics- Tuesdays by appointment.
