

To'hajiilee Community Update from CBNHC: As of November 3, 2022 we have recorded 1475 **positive** total cases of coronavirus. **We have had 25 new positive cases in the past 7 days**, and 13 positive cases for the month of November. **October= 13.7 % November = 14%**

Bivalent Boosters given: 227

5-11 YEAR OLDS: 121 #1, 60 #2, 28 #3

6 MONTHS- 4 YEAR OLDS: 11 #1, 11 #2

News: Sadly, **cases are on the rise here in To'hajiilee**. Please remain vigilant- wear your masks, avoid large crowds, maintain hand hygiene. All these practices will also help limit your exposure to not only Covid, but flu as well. An average of 450 cases per day were reported in New Mexico in the last week. Cases have **increased by 54 percent** from the average two weeks ago. Deaths have increased by 188 percent. Since the beginning of the pandemic, at least 1 in 3 residents have been infected, a total of 629,318 reported cases. At least 1 in 242 residents have died from the coronavirus, a total of 8,647 deaths. Some good news- we do now have the bivalent Omicron vaccine for 5-11 year olds. Please call to make an appointment.
